FACEBOOK PRIVACY POLICY – January 14, 2010**

Pulaski County Special School District notifies all parents of current students through official mailers and sections printed in our current and official student handbooks that students are potentially subjected to having their photographs displayed on our official school website (www.pcssd.org) or in the media solely for educational purposes. Student photographs may also be posted within our school district's official facebook page. PCSSD requires fans of its official facebook page to use their real names and reserves the right to remove fans from its facebook page for any reason including what our organization decrees to be inappropriate commenting, inappropriate picture or video posting, etc. PCSSD may amend its policy related to its facebook page at anytime and it is the fans' responsibility to review changes to this policy.

By participating on PCSSD's official facebook page, depending on your personal account and privacy settings, you may be subject to having your profile picture, name and comments visible to the public. PCSSD does not take responsibility for such actions because such settings are only within the control of the account holder who is a fan of our page, not PCSSD.

Because we care about the safety and privacy of children online, we comply with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act of 1998 (COPPA). COPPA and its accompanying FTC regulation establish United States federal law that protects the privacy of children using the Internet. Our site is not intended to solicit information of any kind from children under 13. It is possible that by fraud or deception we may receive information pertaining to children under 13. If we are notified of this, as soon as we verify the information, we will immediately obtain parental consent or otherwise delete the information from our servers. We maintain a variety of physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect your personal information within facebook by using their resources designed for maximum privacy. For example, we use commercially reasonable tools and techniques to protect against unauthorized access to our systems. Also, we restrict access to personal information to those who need such access in the course of their duties for us. Your own efforts to protect against unauthorized access play an important role in protecting the security of your personal information. You should be sure to sign off when finished using a shared computer, and always log out of any site when viewing personal information. We may have links to other, outside web sites that we do not control. We are not responsible for the content or privacy policies of these sites, and users should check those policies on such sites.
